## Waste Disposal Policy

It is the policy of Lindsay Wilkinson Systems Limited to recognise our responsibilities as an employer for sound waste disposal practices and in particular to comply with Sections 33 and 34 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990.

Specifically we accept our responsibilities to:

- \* prevent the unauthorised or harmful disposal of our waste;
- \* prevent the unauthorised or harmful disposal of our waste by another person;
- \* on the transfer of waste to secure:
  - that the transfer is only to an authorised person or to a person for authorised transport purposes; and
  - that there is transferred such written description of the waste as will enable the other person to avoid the unauthorised or harmful disposal of the waste and to comply with their duty of care.

### Responsibilities

Ben Lindsay and Andrew Wilkinson, Directors and Scheme Nominees have overall responsibility for the maintenance and implementation of the waste disposal policy and will ensure that the policy is properly implemented, monitored and periodically reviewed, in accordance with all statutory provisions.

They will keep under review the requirement for an Environment Agency Waste Carrier License. At the date of signing our view is that we do not yet require one as any waste is bagged and left with the client which leaves it within the definition of 'Household Waste' under the Act.

### Employee and Subcontractor Responsibilities

It is the duty of every employee or subcontractor whilst at work to act within this Waste Disposal Policy.

Failure to observe these duties may lead to disciplinary action.
